DAY NURSERY

Conkers day nursery has been open since 2005. Since being open we have continued to provide quality childcare and have been Ofsted rated "Good' at every inspection. At Conkers children enjoy a daily variety of activities to nurture their social, intellectual, emotional and physical development indoors and out.

Within the setting we have highly qualified staff team including a Manager, two Deputy Manager's and a number of nursery practitioners who care for the children. We also have an onsite cook who makes well-balanced and healthy meals for the children.

We are also a training nursery and provide opportunities for Apprentice Nursery Practitioners to develop their skills and gain the necessary expertise and experience to become fully qualified.

Safeguarding is embedded within the high-quality childcare we provide. Our whole team is DBS checked and approved to work with children, leaving you with the knowledge that your children will be cared and looked after during their early years.

Opening Hours

We are open all year round from 8am to 6pm for babies and children aged up to 5 years, excluding public holidays, weekends and the period between Christmas and New Year.



Our Classrooms

All children are cared for in separate rooms to cater for the children's developmental stage and their age.

We have three classrooms within the setting:

The Spring Room – which is for babies and toddlers up to the age of 2 years old

The Summer Room – which is for children aged between 2 and 3 years of age

The Autumn Room – which is for children aged 3 up to when they go to school

Each classroom is set out to enhance the children's development and ensure the children get the most out of their environment and resources, all of which are regularly checked and monitored by the manager, who risk assesses the setting regularly.



Spring Room

In our Spring classroom, we recognise how important these first, formative months and years of a child's life are. Our staff have trained to work specifically with babies and ensure the babies get emotional and physical nurturing alongside sensory stimulation. The Spring room have their own garden which they use multiple times throughout the day to ensure the babies are getting fresh air and they can develop their physical skills.



Summer Room

In our Summer room, our staff plan for more challenging activities which helps foster their language and literacy skills through social interaction. The children are encouraged to progress and become confident and independent in their play. The toddlers are prepared in readiness for the Autumn Room by learning numbers, days of the week, colours and some shapes in circle time. This also allows for quality time with their key person and helps form a secure attachment.



Autumn Room

In the Autumn Room, we provide a range of educational play opportunities to prepare your child for school, the children will become more independent as they take advantage of free-flow activities between indoors and outdoors. We begin to further the children's curiosity about how and why by using experiments such as sink and float activities. Staff will also encourage the children to engage in sustained shared thinking through problem-solving. We aim for our children to become independent and autonomous learners.







Our Environment

Our nursery is a wonderful place for children to play and learn. Emphasis is placed on learning through play and exploration both inside and outside in the fresh air. We are outside everyday either in the all-weather courtyard, the garden or using the network of private walks around the farm's fields. The nursery provides a welcoming and stimulating environment where children feel secure and able to access challenging and exploratory activities in a safe space.

We recognise the benefits of natural and everyday objects for the children to interact with and this is widely used throughout the setting through heuristic play and treasure baskets.

Starting Nursery

Once you have agreed a start date with the setting, we encourage for you to book in settling-in sessions before the start date, these can be arranged to suit each individual. These are beneficial to both your child and you. This enables your child and you to get to know your key person and for your key person to get to know you, and for your child to get use to the surroundings.

We work alongside health colleagues and require all parents to bring in their child's Healthy Record Book (red book).

We use a nursery software called 'Blossom' which enables you to get updates on your child throughout the day via an app on your phone.





Things to bring to Nursery

Conkers Day Nursery will provide protective clothing for when your child plays with messy activities, although we do not recommend children wear their best clothes to nursery.

Parents will need to provide the following items; they must be clearly labelled in a bag with their name on it:

- Changes of clothes in case of accidents
- Outdoor clothing, wellies, coat, sun hat (depending on weather conditions)
- Nappies, creams and wet wipes
- · A comforter if needed.

We do ask that children do not wear jewellery in the nursery for their own safety and for the safety of others. The nursery cannot be responsible for the loss of such items

A well-balanced diet

Our nursery strives to provide the best start in life for your child and recognises the importance of a well-balanced diet. We provide healthy snacks and hot nutritious meals served straight from our kitchen.

Our Menus are carefully planned to ensure that your child is offered different types of fruit and vegetables each day and with a variety of food to ensure a well-balanced, healthy lifestyle, in line with National Healthy Eating Standards.

We provide the following:

Breakfast

Variety of cereals, toast, muffins, crumpets and porridge.

Morning snack

Fresh fruit, vegetables or healthy snack.

Lunch

A daily variety of protein, carbohydrates and vegetables with a healthy pudding.

Afternoon snack

Fresh fruit, vegetables or healthy snack.

Tea

A light meal served with vegetables or salad.

Milk is provided at breakfast, morning and afternoon snacks.


